

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHAT IS THIS EXTENDED BLOOM GARDEN ALL ABOUT?

A great garden has flowers blooming from spring all the way until the frost. But picking the right plants to achieve that can be tricky. This Extended Bloom Garden takes all the guess work out of the equation and is jam packed with varieties that are known to have exceptionally long bloom times so you can enjoy beauty in your garden longer than ever before.

DO I NEED TO PLANT ALL THE PLANTS NEXT TO ONE ANOTHER?

We created this collection because we are often asked how to design an entire garden scene. When all the plants in the collection are grown together, a wonderful garden is crafted. However, it is by no means necessary to plant everything near each other. The wonderful thing about this Big Garden collection is that there will be enough plants to produce a single dense garden, or to plant all the plants separately in and around the garden as you desire. It's the gardener's choice!

WHEN WILL MY PLANTS BLOOM?

The plants in this Big Garden have been strategically selected so that you will have some plants flowering on and off from late spring through fall. A great garden has plants that flower at different times of the year, and that is exactly what this collection will achieve.

WHAT TO DO IN THE WINTER?

All the plants in the collection are perennials, so there is nothing to do in the winter. Because they are perennials, the first season they will be growing their root systems. However, by the second and third season their flower power will really start to shine.

FIRST THINGS FIRST...

When your plant arrives from Roberta's, remove from the shipping box immediately. Remove plastic bag and sleeve from around potted plant(s).

Discard any packing material clinging to the leaves or soil. Pull away any yellow or brown leaves that may have occurred during transit. If you can not plant it into garden or larger pot within a few days, make sure it stays well watered. Keep bulb(s) inside packing material until ready to plant into ground or container. Put in a cool, protected area and plant as soon as possible. For extended storage time, place in refrigerator for up to 3 weeks.

When ready to plant, do the job as early in the day as possible to avoid extreme soil temperatures that prevent proper water uptake from the roots. Water them in well and whisper a few words of wisdom.

The Extended Bloom Garden Collection




QUICK REFERENCE PLANTING GUIDE

LIGHT/SUN EXPOSURE:	Full to Partial Sun
USDA HARDINESS ZONES:	5-9
PLANT TYPE	Perennial
WATER:	Regular watering a couple times per week

GARDEN LAYOUT

PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS | Remove plastic bag and/ or sleeve from around potted plant(s) Dig holes twice the width of the root ball and about 5 to 6 inches deep. Pack soil firmly around roots. Fill with soil and pack in firmly covering entire root zone. Water thoroughly. May be planted in the ground or in larger 12-18" wide pots.

Keep bulb(s) inside packing material until ready to plant into ground or container. Plant bulbs in the garden once the ground has thawed accordingly. Otherwise plant bulbs into 6 inch pots separately or combine into larger pots.

4. Phenomenal Lavender (Lavendula)


